Hi Everyone!

I am just writing with the excellent news that we will be reopening fully at Winton, St Peter's, Corpus Christi and Mudeford Infants from September. Yipee! Thank you to everyone who supported us and even did extra to help other families throughout the Shutdown, because of you, we're able to bounce back! Parents of children at Mudeford Juniors, apologies, we are still working on this and we will write to you under separate cover.

We will, of course, have some adaptations to our daily routines and practices – we are allowed to mix the school bubbles but will need to minimise this as much as possible so that in the event of an outbreak we can isolate small groups effectively and not have to close entirely – I am sure none of us wants that again! Most of our children will be in their Year Group Bubbles during the day and we will maintain this during Breakfast and After School where possible. Sometimes we may need to group two years together and use other areas of the school, but please be assured that safety and ability to continue should a localised outbreak occur remains our top priority.

Details of the new routines – which doors to use, where and how to pick up and drop off etc – will come out to you in late August. We are working with each of our schools to make a Risk Assessment that dovetails into theirs, but guidance changes rapidly so we want to make sure that what we send out will be accurate. We will be publishing our Risk Assessments on our website for complete transparency.

We will also now be picking up emails & Facebook messages, going through the payments made whilst we were furloughed, allocating them and generally getting ready for re-opening in September. New parents will receive a Welcome Pack shortly. Apologies if you have sent us a query about payments or when we are opening – we have just finalised re-opening plans for the above schools this week.

A note about emails also – if you have asked to be removed from our mailing list since lockdown and have received this email it's just we haven't yet gone through all of the emails received – please ignore this or if you wish to be removed now, please let us know. A child leaving us does not automatically remove you from our mailing – we have many families who use us sporadically – so you do need to let us know if you'd like us to remove you :) and will be clearing the inbox over the next week.

If we have to do this for you there will be a **£10 admin fee** I'm afraid as it is so time consuming for us, but it'll take you less than a minute!! It will also cause absolute chaos if we see Bertie is in Year Three on the register, allocate him to his Year Bubble and lo, he is now Year 4! Arrrgh! This is YOUR responsibility. Please click 'edit child' then next to 'School' there are two boxes – edit the second one to reflect the new class. Thank youuuuuu!!

I will close by saying then that **booking will be open from the 20th July**, this is only for new parents and parents who continued to pay their retainer during the crisis (or who contacted us and we made an agreement to use our Corona Support Fund for you) do please go into the portal and book whatever you need – the earlier you book the better we can plan!
